

Ring It!



The children who participate in this activity will play a ring toss game to help them focus on trusting God in fearful situations.

*Ask the kids to name people who can help them when they are afraid. Then instruct the kids to take turns opening your Bible to the bookmarks. Read each verse about trusting God.

*Play the game. The kids will take turns tossing the rings onto the egg carton. Depending on where the rings lands, each player will name a person who can help him when he is afraid (*who*), a place where he might be afraid (*where*), or a Bible verse about trusting God when he is afraid.

(Option: Award 100 points for answering *who*, 200 points for *where*, and 500 points for telling a Bible verse.)

Materials needed:

- *Five Craft sticks
- *Egg carton
- *Foam Cups

Instructions:

- *On five craft sticks, print the following: who, who, where, where, Bible Verse.
- *Stick the craft sticks into the bottom of an upside-down egg carton.
- *Make a ring by cutting the rim from a foam cup.
