



Responsibilities of Youth Sunday School Leadership

Youth Teacher

Prepare

- Prepares through personal Bible Study
- Plans and prepares in advance for Bible-learning activities for foundational Bible teaching.
- Contacts members, prospects, and families regularly to meet needs.

Encounter

- Arrives on time
- Engages in Bible-learning activities building a relationship with youth for the purpose of fundamental Bible teaching and ministry.
- Builds positive relationships with youth and families.

Continue

- Leads youths toward faith in Jesus Christ and guides them to serve Him through worship, evangelism, fellowship, discipleship, and ministry.
- Sets a positive example by living as an authentic witness of Christ and through full involvement in the ministry of the church.
- Encourages and affirms parent/youth relationships by providing take home leaflets, and by calling attention to devotions in EC (essential connection)

Youth Department Director

Prepare

- Leads in planning and administering the total work of the class/department.
- Meets regularly with teachers for prayer, planning, and evaluation.
- Evaluates the needs of the class/department and recommends actions related to space, budget, curriculum, supplies, and other resources.

Encounter

- Greets youth when they arrive.
- Serves as lead teacher for the class/department, directing overall teaching and learning experiences.
- Leads group learning experiences (General Sessions)
- Maintains general records for the class/department. May choose to enlist a secretary to assist in record keeping and tasks.



Continue

- Sets a positive example by living as an authentic witness of Christ and through full involvement in the ministry of the church.
- Maintains prospect files for the department.
- Makes assignments related to evangelism and outreach, fellowship, ministry, and Bible teaching.

Youth Division Director

Prepare

- Meets regularly with the Sunday School Council.
- Coordinates work of the Youth Division and develops the organization.
- Discovers, enlists, and trains new youth leaders and teachers.
- Meets regularly with leaders and teachers for planning and evaluation.
- Evaluates the needs of the division and recommends actions related to space, budget, curriculum, supplies, and other resources.

Encounter

- Evaluates, encourages, affirms, and directs youth leaders and teachers.
- Greets visiting families with youth and assists in locating the appropriate youth department.
- Coordinates and promotes outreach activities, prospect-discovery, and first contact.
- Serves as a FAITH Group Leader or Team Leader (for churches using FAITH: Sunday School Evangelism Strategy.)

Continue

- Sets a positive example by living as an authentic witness of Christ and through full involvement in the ministry of the church.
- Maintains active prospect records for the Youth Division.
- Leads out and encourages teachers to participate in ministry to youth and their families.
