God loves everyone. Because He loves everyone, He has a plan for you.

God made people and planned for them to take care of the world, be His friends, and love Him. But, from the first man (Adam) and woman (Eve) people have not loved and obeyed God (Genesis 1:28-29).



When people disobey God and choose their way instead of God's way, they sin. Sin means disobeying God. The Bible Says everyone disobeys (sins) Romans 3:23. The Bible also tells us sin keeps us away from God (Romans 6:23).

Because God loves you and wants you to choose His way, He sent Jesus His only Son to be the Savior of the world. God wants us to believe (trust) in Jesus (1 John 4:14-15).



God wants us to ask Jesus to forgive us for disobeying Him, and tell Him we will follow Him for the rest of our lives (1 John 1:9).

When you tell Jesus you are very sorry (repent) for disobeying Him, Jesus will forgive you (Acts 3:19).
