FISH Club Ideas

Use the FISH strategy in an existing Bible club or start a new Bible club using the FISH strategy.

FISH Clubs look like this:

Week One: Ask God for 1 person you can pray for this month who needs to know Jesus.

Week Two: Have someone remind the group that God will use them to impact their campus.

Week Three: Have students tell their story as a reminder of the miracle that happens every time God changes a life.

Week Four: Do an act of service for a group of people at your school. Ex. Gift bags for teachers.

Week Five: Invite the person you've been praying for to the meeting. Present the gospel in a clear and meaningful way.



Code2life Ideas

- Make sure your story is on Code2life.com. If it isn't, go to www.code2life.com and add it.
- Order or print cards to pass out.
- Give cards to students who:
 - ✓ Need Jesus
 - ✓ Need to read the FAQ's about Christianity.
 - ✓ Have prayed to receive Christ and need follow-up materials.
 - ✓ Are new believers and need to put their story online.

- Keep a Bible with you to give to someone who doesn't have a Bible.
- Take this Bible to non-Bible places such as school, restaurants, mall, work, etc.
- Use one of the five ways included in the cover to share the gospel with someone.
