

(What Are You) Thankful Four?



Materials Needed:

- *Construction paper or scrapbook paper
- *Scissors
- *Ribbon or Yarn
- *Markers
- *Hole punch

Instructions:

* Cut out before hand or let the older children cut out the number “4”. Allow the children to write on the number “4” what they are thankful “for”. Then when they are finished have each child hole punch the top corner of the “4” and tie a ribbon/yarn to it. Allow each child to tell what she has written and why she is thankful. Encourage the kids to take them home and hang them somewhere as a reminder to be thankful!
