There are over 4.5 million people living in the state of Guanajuato, Mexico. Only 1.32 percent of the population is considered to be evangelical. Many throughout the region do not understand that salvation is through Jesus alone and not through good works, church membership, baptism or rituals.

In the last year, with the help of the Cooperative Program, 25 teams of

Oklahoma Baptists brought the Good News of Jesus Christ to the people of Guanajuato, Mexico. Each team distributed an average of 2,000 Bibles and witnessed anywhere from 14 to 76 professions of faith per trip!

There are over 6 million people living in Guerrero, Mexico. Less than 6 percent of the population is evangelical Christian. There are only 35 Baptist churches in the state. In 2005, ten BGCO Partnership Missions Teams traveled to Guerrero, Mexico, for construction and renovation projects, prayer, marriage and family retreats, Vacation Bible Schools, saturation evangelism and leadership training seminars.

The population of Chicago, Illinois, is in excess of 8.5 million. There are only 210 Southern Baptist churches in the area. In comparison, there are over 1,700 Southern Baptist churches in Oklahoma with a population of just over 3 million people.
