## Falls Creek is always the same and it always changes. When you read through the Sponsor Book, you will notice a few changes for 2010...

Morning Flip-Flop Continues - The morning middle school and high school times will operate the same as they did last summer. Both teaching times will be in the tabernacle each morning, the high school will start at 9:30 a.m. for teaching and the middle school will join them at 10:05 a.m. for worship. The high school will leave the tabernacle at 10:40 a.m. and the middle school will have their teaching to 11:10 a.m. The in-cabin Bible study time remains at 11:30 each morning.

Adult Leadership Investment — We were able to invest in over 1,000 leaders last summer. So, on Tuesday and Wednesday evenings, during the Evening Tabernacle Experience, Falls Creek will once again host two identical Adult Leadership Investment times for adult leaders who work with students throughout the year (Sunday school teachers, sponsors, youth ministry staff, youth parents, etc.). This one hour training will focus on building a quality youth ministry. Each church can divide their leaders and leave half their leaders with their students on Tuesday night, while the other half go to the training time; then on Wednesday they can swap.

Youth Minister's Wives Fellowship - Youth Minister's wives are invited to attend a special fellowship on Thursday after the Evening Tabernacle Experience in the Massey Chapel. We know this time together will honor these wonderful servants!
