Fran Prezant is Senior Vice President of Abilities, USA, a nonprofit organization dedicated to enhancing self sufficiency, independence and participation by people with disabilities, and Director of Research and Evaluation at Abilities. In 1986 she joined the faculty at Indiana University of Pennsylvania where she taught in the Dept. of Special Education and developed and administered the Parent Information Project, a program for parents of children with disabilities. She is currently working on a children's book related to career role models and children with disabilities.
