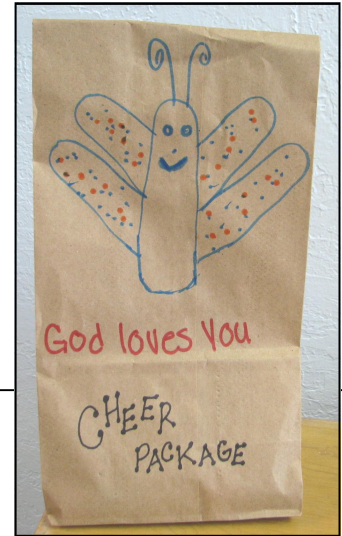

The Big Idea

Create %Cheer Packages+to brighten someone's day!



Lunch size paper bags

Markers, Colored Pencils or Crayons

Variety of simple verses for kids to write on the bags OR Bible Verse stickers

Individually wrapped Treat items (hard candy mints, peanut butter crackers, animal crackers, cheese crackers, bite size candy bars, chewing gum, etc.)



Things to Gather



Put it Together

Allow children to decorate a bag with the words %Cheer Package+and any other decorations or appropriate Bible verses they want to add. Once the bags have been decorated, assist the boys and girls in placing one or two of each of the items brought. Older kids may enjoy including a note written on paper that might include the following:
